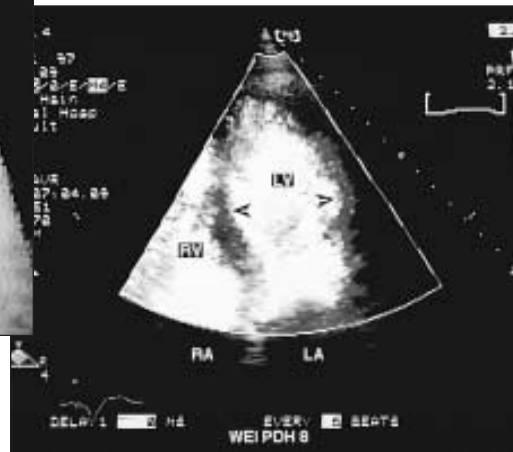
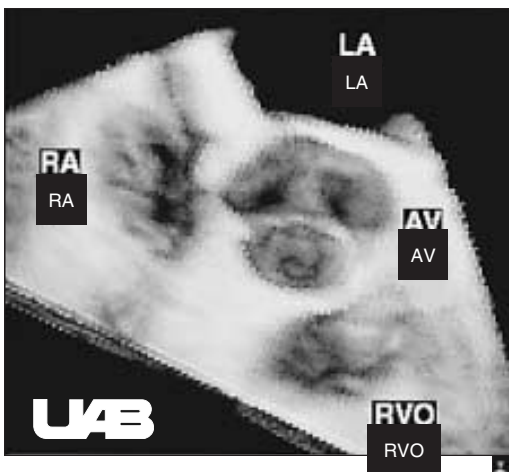


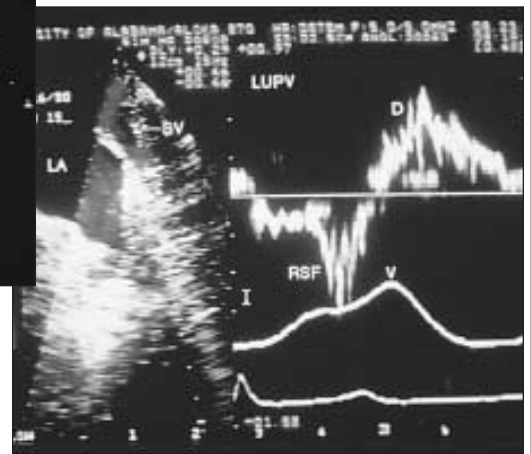

Purpose: This one-day symposium is designed to provide a comprehensive review of echocardiography using case studies dealing with valvular heart disease, endocarditis, valve repair, peripheral arterial diseases, prosthetic valves, heart failure, tumors, embolism, trauma, dissection, adult congenital heart disease, coronary artery disease, stress, 3-dimensional, LV strain/strain rate, Doppler tissue imaging and contrast echocardiography. Although the symposium is designed mainly for physicians, we invite technologists, nurses, and other health and industry professionals to attend. This one day Conference is free-of-charge to non-physicians and physicians-in-training and \$50.00 to physicians. **Continental breakfast, luncheon and refreshment breaks are included.** There are no special prerequisites.

Objectives: We expect the attendees to acquire and enhance their knowledge of various aspects of echocardiography, including contrast echocardiography, and to be able to describe the uses of basic and some advanced ultrasound techniques for cardiac assessment.
